Site Tour – One optional site tour on January 21, 2016 at 9:00 a.m. CT (see Section 3.0 for details)

1.0 **Site Background**

The Outagamie County Department of Recycling & Solid Waste opened the Tri-County Single Stream Recycling facility in 2009. This facility is part of the BOW entity of Brown, Outagamie and Winnebago Counties. The facility is the largest publicly owned and operated Single Stream Recycling facility in the United States. The site is located at 1419 Holland Rd in Appleton, WI.

2.0 **Information Request**

Due to the ever increasing annual tonnages of recyclables, along with the addition of a 2nd shift in 2013, the volume of dust accumulation and other types of maleficent odors warrant an assessment of what varieties of odor/dust control systems are available that are specifically designed for Single Stream Recycling facilities. The specific areas that need to be addressed are the (MRF) Material Recovery facility tip floor and the In-Feed Conveyance System prior to the single stream materials entrance into the sorting facility. It is critical that that misting system control dust without actual mist or droplets coming in contact with the single stream materials.

We are seeking information and proposals on a system(s) that address both odor and dust concerns prior to entry into the sorting plant.

The County reserves the right to award a system from this Request for Information/Proposal or we may use the information gathered and issue a separate Request for Proposal. It will be the County's sole decision to determine the outcome from this RFI/P.

3.0 **Site Tour**

In order for vendors to become familiar with the site there will be one site tour on January 21, 2016 at 9:00 a.m. CT. No individual tours will be given. All vendors will meet at the Department of Recycling and Solid Waste (1419 Holland Rd, Appleton). Since the tour will include going into the plant, which will be in operation. The use of PPE (hard hat, safety vest, eye protection) is mandatory. If you do not bring your own protection, PPE will be provided. A site tour is not mandatory to submit information on your solution.

4.0 **Submittal**

Provide one original and two copies of information.

Provide the following -

- Completed Information & Proposal Form.
- Detailed information on your system and how it will handle the dust and odor in the County's facility.
- Cost information. Include initial lump sum cost (equipment and installation) as well as any consumable cost. If there is a consumable cost, include how often that would need to be purchased.
- Completed Attachment A – Insurance and Indemnification.

6.0 **Clarification and/or Revisions to the Specifications and Requirements**

Where there appears to be a conflict between the RFI/P and any addendum issued, the last addendum issued will prevail.

It is the Vendor's responsibility to assure receipt of all addenda, which would be posted on the County's website at www.outagamie.org then Bids & Proposals under this project. Upon posting, such addenda shall become part of the RFI/P and binding on Proposer(s).
